

Bloody Day in Aleppo

September 30, 2016

On Friday the 30th of September armed terrorist groups shelled the Armenian-populated Nor Kyugh and Villat districts of Aleppo.

Five Armenians were killed and 11 were wounded after missiles fell on homes located near the St. Mary Armenian Apostolic Church. The local ambulance transferred the wounded to the nearest still functioning hospital.

We, as the Armenian Evangelical Community in Syria send our condolences to and express solidarity with the families of the victims, as well as wishing the relatives of the victims consolation, courage and steadfastness and wish the wounded a speedy recovery.
